

Snap! Integers

2 Players

Materials:

Deck of Cards, A-10 (take out the Js, Qs, and Ks)

Object of the game: to collect all cards in play.

Red cards are negative integers

Black cards are positive integers

A = 1, 2 = 2, 3 = 3, etc.

Directions:

1. Pass out cards so that all cards are in play. Do not look at your cards.
2. On the count of three, both players slap down the first cards in their deck.
3. The first person to correctly sum the integers equivalent to the cards, wins the pair of cards.
4. If there is a tie or a dispute over who said it first, have a play off. Count out three more cards face down, and then slap the fourth card down face up, the winner of all of the cards in play is the first person to correctly sum these integers. Repeat when necessary.
5. The winner of the game is the person who either collects all the cards in the deck, or has the most cards at the end of the allotted time.

Extensions: You can add in the J as 11, Q as 12, and/or K as 13.
